Vilnius (Lithuania)

The conference State-of-the-art and future of terminology methodology and applications will take place on 12-13 October 2011 at the Institute of the Lithuanian Language (Vilnius, Lithuania).

The conference will take place within the context of the 90th anniversary of the establishment of Terminologijos Komisija. The presentations and the debates will focus on the following sub-themes:

1. History of terminology in Lithuania
2. Terminology science: history and evolution (focus on academic research)
3. Terminology work, terminology portals and terminological data maintenance today and tomorrow (focus on the content industries)
4. Content-driven ICTs: terminology and other language and content resources (focus on ICT & industrial data; advanced applications)
5. Terminology and language services (focus on language industries and language service providers; translation, localization, technical documentation, etc.)
6. Terminology and LSP teaching (focus on academic research)

The planned deadline for abstract submission is 1 April 2011 and it is expected to get definitive version of papers by 15 August 2011.
