This conference addresses the implications of the internationalisation of higher education in the Nordic countries. TERMCAT publishes an online dictionary of terminology used in computer products

To help taking linguistic and terminological decisions to create or translate computer products in Catalan, TERMCAT publishes an [online dictionary of terminology used in computer products](#): a set of entries that gather the most common terminology and phraseology of this field.



More than 2.450 terminological entries related to fields of interest from the localization perspective: office automation, graphics arts and edition, electronic commerce, mobile phones, Internet, videogames, information society...

More than 3.650 entries that gather examples of phraseological units, in Catalan and English, that are commonly used when creating and translating computer products. In this case, the Catalan phrase is one of several appropriate proposals. For further information, see: www.termcat.cat.

Ole Våge: "Legal concepts in aquaculture in Norwegian and Chilean Spanish: a brief discussion on two approaches" Synaps no 25/2010, pp 45-51:

This paper discusses differences between legal concepts in Norway and Chile in the case of aquaculture. While a traditional approach will merely detect differences between the concepts in question, a functional analysis will reveal why these differences occur. When analyzing the function of the concept 'aquaculture licence' in the two legal systems, we find that in Chile the concept is a legal adaptation to the fact that water is a public good. In Norway, on the other hand, the concept has been a response to the need to control the economic development along the coast.

Ole Våge is since April this year employed in The Terminology Service of The Language Council of Norway. Before that time he was a doctoral student at The Norwegian School of Economics in Bergen. Synaps is the permanent academic journal published by the School's Department of Professional and Intercultural Communication.

Denne artikkelen drøftar ulikskapar mellom juridiske omgrep i Noreg og Chile for fagfeltet fiskeoppdrett. Medan ei tradisjonell tilnærming berre påviser ulikskapar mellom omgrepa, vil ei funksjonell analyse forklare kvifor desse ulikskapane oppstår. Når vi analyserer funksjonen til omgrepet 'oppdrettsløyve' i dei to juridiske systema, finn vi at i Chile er omgrepet ei juridisk tilpassing til den kjensjerninga at vatn er eit offentleg gode. I Noreg har derimot omgrepet vore eit svar på behovet for å kontrollere den økonomiske utviklinga langs kysten.

Ole Våge har vore tilsatt i Språkrådets terminologiteneste sidan April i år. Før den tid var han doktorgradsstudent ved Noregs handelshøgskole i Bergen. Synaps er det faste akademiske tidsskriftet utgjeve av høgskolens Institutt for fagspråk og interkulturell kommunikasjon.
