New publications of the Panlatin Network of Terminology

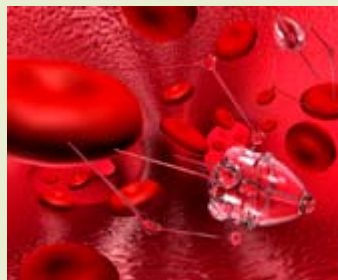
