

Cooperation Agreement



The European Association for Terminology – EAFT) and the International Information Centre for Terminology (Infoterm) conclude this Cooperation Agreement with a view to collaborating in compliance with the following aims and conditions:

- Cooperation and provision of mutual support with regard to the promotion of qualified terminological
 activities and specialized terminology research within the Terminology Community, including EAFT's
 Members and Infoterm's Members as well as international organizations such as UNESCO, WHO, ISO
 etc.
- Collaboration in establishing and promoting terminology cooperation infrastructures, such as terminology networks and terminology centres.
- Mutual exchange of information, mutual support and, when feasible and useful, cooperation with regard to projects, meetings and publications in the areas of terminology, lexicography, linguistics, language learning, information management and management of structured contents.
- Regular exchange of information in the form of newsletters and newsflashes. Linking each other's homepage on the Internet.
- Collaboration in standardization frameworks at the international level, where methodology standards related to terminology, as well as information and language resources are discussed.
- Infoterm shall support, as far as possible, the terminology related activities of EAFT and shall provide assistance whenever necessary and feasible.
- Infoterm and EAFT shall offer each other most favoured conditions, whenever possible.
- By virtue of this Agreement EAFT shall be a Member of Infoterm, and Infoterm shall be a Member of EAFT.
- The Agreement shall be valid for an initial period of two years from the date of its signature by both parties, renewable by tacit agreement, unless terminated by either party at a three months' written notice prior to the end of the year.
- Any amendments and additions to the Agreement, especially those having a bearing on finances, personnel resources and status of the cooperation partners, shall be agreed upon in writing.
