It offers definitions and denominations in Catalan, with equivalent terms in Spanish and English and, where appropriate, international anatomical terms.

It is the online version of the *Diccionari d'oftalmologia* ('Dictionary of Ophthalmology') that was published by TERMCAT with support from the Government of Catalonia and the assessment of specialists from the University of Barcelona and the Catalan Society of Ophthalmology.
