### TOTH 2014: Call for papers

The forthcoming edition of the international conference *Terminology & Ontology: Theories and applications* (TOTH) will be held at the University of Savoie on 12 and 13 June 2014, in Chambéry (France). The TOTH conferences aim to bridge the gap between terminology and ontology by highlighting the contributions that the one makes to the other and by opening up new perspectives for both theoretical and practical developments. A one-and-a-half day training session takes place before the conference on 10 and 11 June, focused this year on text analysis for onomasiological purposes.
